### DRIVER TRAINING RECORD

Completion of a Training Day is necessary for participating in Trips with a category above Family Shiny.

The training days are scheduled regularly throughout the year, but you can join the Club after three trips and complete training at the next opportunity. However training does count as one of the three required trips if you complete training before forwarding your membership application.
